Court ordered a new investigation 'false' Altink

AMSTERDAM / ASSEN - The prosecutor in Amsterdam set a new judicial investigation against the artist Cor van L [REDACTED] from Holthe, who two years ago was suspected counterfeit paintings Groninger Ploeg Altink painter (1885-1971) have offered for auction. This has determined the Amsterdam Court. The court found that the prosecutor, the case against Van L [REDACTED] March last year has made it archived for lack of evidence, then insufficient research.

Thus appeared a manuscript medical examination by the Forensic Laboratory in Rijswijk until June, when the case was already dismissed in March. The report found that some disputed Altink- cloths were wrongly signed with the name of Altink. The Court finds that the first officer's report to the Van L [REDACTED] had to wait as blasting result.
